




# My First Long-Haul Flight




One day, Mommy and Daddy decided to go on vacation and take Calvin with them. They packed their bags, renewed their passports, and headed to the airport to catch a plane.






Mommy, Daddy, and Calvin, and everyone

North America from Asia.




In San Francisco, Mommy, Daddy, and Calvin

across the Pacific ocean.




Calvin gets the window seat again, but


